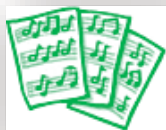

- ♪ Applications due September 22, 2016 (online audio recordings and audition submissions, and original applications postmarked)
- ♪ **All-State Chorus Coordinator:** Robert Todd, rdtfl@aol.com
- ♪ 2017 All-State Chorus Conductor: Dr. Madeline Bridges
- ♪ Qualifications: teacher must be a FEMEA member in good standing, elementary students must be 4th or 5th grade and enrolled in a music course taught by teacher, teacher may nominate 1-5 students, completed application, application fees, and audio recording (made through Audacity)

All-State Orff Ensemble

- ♪ Applications due September 22, 2016 (online video recordings and audition submissions, and original applications postmarked)
- ♪ **All-State Orff Ensemble Coordinator:** Lisa Hewitt, femeaorff@gmail.com
- ♪ 2017 All-State Orff Ensemble Conductors: Randy DeLelles and Jeff Kriske
- ♪ Qualifications: teacher must be a FEMEA member in good standing, elementary students must be 4th or 5th grade and enrolled in a music course taught by teacher, teacher may nominate 1-5 students, completed application, application fees, and video recording (as .mp4 video files no bigger than 854 x 480 resolution)

Ticket to Tampa Scholarship

- ♪ Applications due September 15, 2016
- ♪ One \$500 scholarship to a member to attend the FMEA PD Conference in January
- ♪ Qualifications: FEMEA member, never been to FMEA PD Conference, and have been teaching elementary music in Florida for less than three years

Janice Lancaster PD Scholarship

- ♪ Applications due February 15, 2017
- ♪ Two \$500 scholarships to members for use toward professional development of the members' choices
- ♪ Funding may be applied toward: Graduate-level coursework in an accredited Music Education degree program, or Workshop/conference registration, transportation, and/or housing (this funding may not be used to pay membership dues for any organization or towards FMEA PD conference/FEMEA Summer Conference).
- ♪ Qualifications: FEMEA member in good standing for 2 years, completed application

Dorothy Land Past President's Grant

- ♪ Applications due February 15, 2017
- ♪ \$2,500 allocated for providing grants to members. A limited number of grants will be awarded, up to \$1,000 each. FEMEA may choose to provide partial funding for any grants submitted.
- ♪ Grant funds available for one fiscal year after awarded and should not be used to purchase everyday supplies normally included in the regular school budget
- ♪ Qualifications: FEMEA member in good standing, completed application, and approval of school administration
